What is Focus on The Family's "The Truth Project"? The Barna Research Group has revealed a stunning statistic: Only nine percent of professing Christians hold to a biblical worldview. A personal sense of significance is rarely experienced, we spend our money and time on things that fail to satisfy, and we begin to wonder what life's ultimate purpose really is. We are, in short, losing our bearings as a people and as a nation. To counter this downward slide, Focus on The Family has launched one of the most powerful and ambitious projects in the history of its ministry: THE TRUTH PROJECT.

The Truth Project is a twelve week DVD based small group experience. Watch a (very interesting!) DVD, then discuss it in a small group context. This study is a starting point for looking at all of life from a Biblical perspective. We believe this curriculum can be a catalyst for exponential change within the body of Christ, as people are "transformed by the renewing of their mind" (Rom 12:2). As He has throughout history, God continues to call ordinary people to make an eternal difference in our world.

Colossians 2:16-23

¹⁶ So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, ¹⁷ which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ. ¹⁸ Let no one cheat you of your reward, taking delight in *false* humility and worship of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, ¹⁹ and not holding fast to the Head, from whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase *that is* from God.

²⁰ Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as *though* living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations—²¹ “Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle,” ²² which all concern things which perish with the using—according to the commandments and doctrines of men? ²³ These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in self-imposed religion, *false* humility, and neglect of the body, *but are* of no value against the indulgence of the flesh.
